Policy

Otters Nursery Schools comply with health and safety regulations and the Welfare Requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage in making our setting a no-smoking environment - both indoors and outdoors.

All staff, visitors and persons on the nursery premises must follow the procedure:

Procedure

- All staff, parents and volunteers are made aware of our no-smoking policy.
- We display no-smoking signs.
- The No Smoking policy is stated in our information brochure for parents.
- We actively encourage no smoking by having information for parents and staff about where to get help to stop smoking if they are seeking this information.
- Staff who smoke must not do so during working hours.
- Staff who smoke must not do so on or in the vicinity of the nursery premises including all outside areas.
- Staff who smoke must not do so whilst wearing any part of the Otters Nursery School uniform at any time.
- Staff who smoke during their break must make every effort to reduce the effect of the odour and lingering effects of passive smoking for children and colleagues.
